Blood testing is a window into the body that allows us to better evaluate organ function, which gives us insight on how best to help your pet stay healthy. Liver, kidney, and thyroid conditions, as well as conditions such as diabetes, are more easily and successfully treated when diagnosed early. A physical examination alone cannot completely determine internal organ function. Wellness blood-laboratory analysis gives us additional information regarding your pet's overall health.
